

**ELECTION NOTICE**

**for the election of representatives in the Senate, the Faculty Councils and the Student Convention of Deggendorf Institute of Technology from 12 May to 23 May 2025**

In accordance with Art. 48 of the Bavarian Higher Education Innovation Act (BayHIG), Sections 8, 32 and 42 of the Constitution of Deggendorf Institute of Technology and Sections 2 ff. of the Statutes for the Organisation of University Elections at Deggendorf Institute of Technology (election statutes), the representatives in the Senate and the Faculty Council, and the representatives in the Student Convention are newly elected by the members of the group to which they belong.

Pursuant to the University Constitution of Deggendorf Institute of Technology, these boards and committees include, without prejudice to Art. 50 Para. 1 BayHIG, the following group representatives to be elected:

\* The two student representatives in the Senate are elected by the Student Convention in accordance with Section 8 of the Constitution of Deggendorf Institute of Technology.

\*\* The Student Convention is made up of two elected student representatives from each faculty. The election is held across all faculties. The Student Convention consists of the candidate with the highest and second-highest number of votes per faculty. If there are no or not enough candidates for a faculty, these mandates are allocated among the remaining candidates according to the highest number of votes, regardless of faculty affiliation.

The representatives in the individual collegial bodies shall be elected in ballots separated according to the individual collegial bodies and groups. The terms of office of the representatives in the Senate, the Faculty Councils and the Student Convention will commence on 01 October 2025. The terms of office of the student representatives end on 30 September 2026, while those of the other groups end on 30 September 2028.

Voting rights are subject to registration in the electoral roll. The electoral roll can be viewed in the following rooms

and may be consulted **from 09 April to 11 April 2025, from 8.00am bis 4.00pm (Friday until 12.00pm)**. Objections against non-registration or incorrect registration in the elec-

toral register may be filed in writing with the returning officer by **15 April 2025, 4.00 pm**, at the latest.

Those entitled to vote are requested to submit **nominations** separately according to their committees to the returning officer in the period **from 25 March until 4:00pm on 08 April 2025**.

Nominations must be made in writing. **Sample nominations forms are available at the respective** faculty secretary's office and on the university website (<https://www.th-deg.de/de/studierende/campusleben#hochschulwahlen>).

Nominations for the election of representatives in the Senate and for the student representatives in the Student Convention must be endorsed by at least ten supporters, nominations for the election of representatives in the faculty councils must be endorsed at least five supporters entitled to vote for the respective body.

The nomination must include the surname and given name, the faculty/department and the position/professional title of the candidate. A person entitled to vote may support only **one nomination** for an election to a collegiate body; if a person has endorsed more than one nomination, the endorsement on all the nominations shall be invalid. Nominations that are submitted late are invalid. Only candidates who are included in a valid nomination can be elected.

The number of candidates in a nomination may not exceed three times the number of representatives to be elected.

The names of the individual candidates shall be listed one below the other on the nominations form and shall be numbered consecutively. In addition to the surname, the given name and organisational unit and, for students, the faculty affiliation must be stated. A written declaration of consent of the candidate to stand for election must be submitted along with the nominations form. A candidate may only be listed on one nomination for election to a collegial body.

Approved election proposals will be announced on 28 April 2025 at the latest in the places designated for official announcements at Deggendorf Institute of Technology and on the website of Deggendorf Institute of Technology

12 May, 09.00am, to 23 May 2025, 4.00pm.**

Information on electronic voting and the voting portal will be provided in the election notification.

Voting takes place on separate ballot papers for each collegial body. Each voter is entitled to as many votes as the number of representatives to be elected to the respective body for the group.
